

After performing a motorcycle jump over a large poster as an advertising stunt, he is then taken to the first scene where he performs a high-speed freeway car chase after Brickster, who was ironically cast as the film's main villain. Upon completion, Pepper is given a free roaming lego island, allowing him to explore and complete side missions as he continues to film elsewhere around the island. As the player makes more progress in the missions, it becomes more and more apparent that Brickster has plans of his, and later he kidnaps Infomaniac and shows his tower that his Brickster-Bots have built and made a supercomputer that will take over the whole world. Pepper naturally comes to the rescue, while the owner tries to turn off the supercomputer. He outsmarted and put Brixter in

prison, while the supercomputer was reprogrammed to dismantle the tower, allowing the film to be completed and released on schedule (which the player can view at the end of the game). After all, Pepper has access to all areas of the island, allowing him to overbestle movie scenes and various tasks. The game also gives a little more canon (for example, explaining why Legondos broke up). Characters Most of the original Lego Island and Lego Island 2 cast return. Roni Pepper remains the star of the game, while his adoptive parents Mom and Dad Brickolini continue their career running a pizzeria. Infomaniac's role has been reduced from player leadership to simple cameo. Others retain their roles, such as Ed Mail Postman, Nick and Laura Brick cops, Mrs Post grocer, and others. The studio director is presented, serving as a guide for the player through tricks and giving him different goals throughout the game. Unlike Lego Island and Lego Island 2, Pepper says no dialogue in the game other than grunts and one-word exclamations, making him a silent hero. When performing trick work, however, it can make comments that are more than one word. Gameplay Like Lego Island 2, the player controls Pepper throughout the game, exploring the island in a non-linear style. Players can drive and drive different vehicles throughout the city (only after they have obtained their correct licenses). There are various collectible items scattered throughout that will recover animals consisting of large lego parts, and there are also mini-games in some parts of the city, such as helping one of the grocery store owners arrange and arrange storage boxes. When shooting stunts, the player instructs the director on how to perform tricks in the scene and then practice the room where Pepper practice the driving of the vehicle used in the blue screen (how different Brickster Bots control the mechanics for it). The player then performs the scene by playing a mini-game inside it. Island Xtreme Stunts is a theme that was introduced in 2002 and was discontinued a year later in 2003. It was based on the success of the 1997 video game, LEGO Island, and the 2001 video game, LEGO Island 2: The Brickster's Revenge. The video game on the theme was made for PC, PlayStation 2 and Game Boy Advance and was released in late 2002. Although the theme is said to have been released in 2002, the promotional set that was part of it, the 3925 Brickster Key Chain, was released in late 2001.
